PILOTING INNOWORK IN PORTUGAL

AidLearn has been promoting in Portugal over recent months, the piloting test of the European Project Towards a More Innovative Workplace / InnoWork.

InnoWork

InnoWork aims to create a more favourable environment for innovation in SMEs and improve their adaptability through training resources for development of organisational innovation.

Partnership adapted a model (Fig.1) authored by the Portuguese Association of Creativity and Innovation / Apgico, for the design of an Organisational Innovation Plan.


Handbook of Best practice about Creativity and Sharing activities in Urban Areas;
