

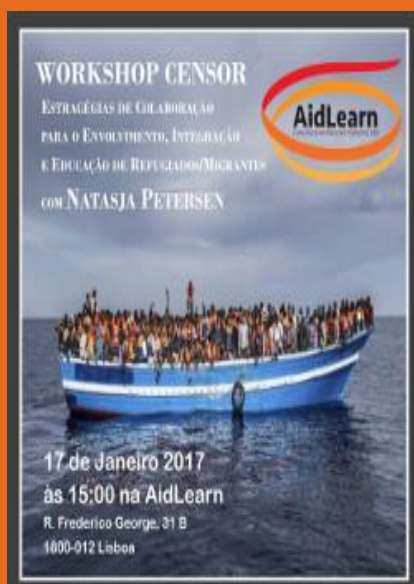

Workshop CENSOR

AidLearn, Consultoria em RH, Lda and *C24Education and Development* (Peterborough, UK) CENSOR accomplished a Workshop, targeted to technicians who work in the social integration of refugees / migrants, with the following objectives:

- Disseminating the increasing importance of dialogue and mutual understanding of people and groups living together in a multicultural and religious community;
- Improving the learning process both of refugees / migrants and trainers through the exchange of ideas and experiences in a multicultural and religious environment;
- Sharing non-formal education methodologies and strategies that enhance and promote understanding of diversity in multicultural communities and dissuade dissimilarities, stereotypes and racism.



AidLearn shared in the workshop the innovative approach of the Project RefugeesIN, which uses cinema as a tool to break stereotypes and portray real and inspiring life stories of ex-refugees who can play a role model for the social inclusion of the newcomers.





PROJECT BACCHUS SME

The project Organisational Diagnosis and B-Learning Tool for Enhancement of the Wine Tourism SME / **BACCHUS SME** is a European Erasmus+ project designed to improve the quality of services provided by SMEs in the Wine Tourism sector.

It wants to develop a diagnostic tool and a course *B-learning*, to be available on the BACCHUS SME platform (on-line), for initial or continuous training.

In the first phase of project development, two questionnaires were designed:

- [Questionnaire on the Enotourist Profile](#), for collecting information on the skills and experience profile of the enotourist, and,
- [Questionnaire on the Wine Tourism Sector](#), for gathering information on the experience and training needs of wine tourism companies.

The information gathered will support the development of a blended training course (face-to-face and distance learning) to improve the professionals' skills in the wine tourism sector.





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PROJECT REFUGEESIN

On the 2nd and 3rd of December 2016 was carried out the [1st Transnational Project Meeting](#) of the Project *Cinema for Refugees Social Inclusion /RefugeesIN*, in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

How can you participate?

We are creating an external pool of experts (EPE) composed by representatives of: 1) refugee communities, 2) adult education and civil society organisations, and 3) film experts, who will be consulted to collect recommendations and suggestions for improvement.

Who is it for?

The products are intended for professionals and organisations (education and civil society) working on the social inclusion of refugees. The project also aims to raise public awareness about cohesive and inclusive societies as well as on the role of cinema in promoting representations of more inclusive societies.

When will it happen?

Jan. - Jun. 2017: Brochure. Real-life successful inclusion stories of former refugees

Jan. 2017-Feb. 2018: Film Catalogue. Feature length films and short documentaries

Jun. 2017 - Feb. 2018: Course. Shooting the short documentaries

Jan.-Jun. 2018: Guide: Recommendations for the best use of the pack assets

Mar.-Apr. 2018: Promotional Seminars

Jul. 2018: RefugeesIN Package delivery

Oct.-Nov. 2018: Conferences & Films Festivals

How are we doing it?

RefugeesIN offers an innovative cinema-based Package (with Brochure, Film Catalogue, Course and Guide) for use by professionals, in order to encourage intercultural dialogue, to combat discrimination against refugees and to promote their social inclusion.

During Pilot Courses short documentaries are made by the refugees themselves and from real stories of social inclusion

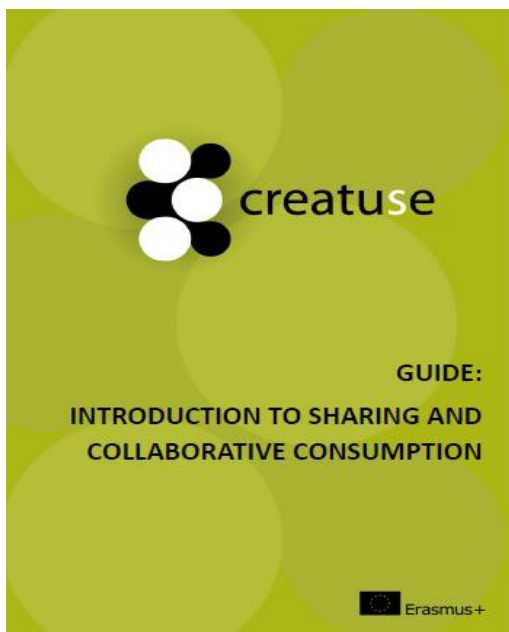
Attended the course 16 participants, coming from the partner organisations (Italy, Portugal, Spain, the United Kingdom, Poland and Turkey) of the [Project "Creatuse"](#).

AidLearn participants were also the trainers about the World Café methodology.

The approval in the course allowed the attribution of 1.5 ECVET credits. The course included 6 modules:

- *Creative Problem Solving*
- *NLP (Neuro Linguistic Programming)*
- *Social Innovation and the Sharing Production/Consumption*
- *Employment Opportunities from Sharing, Active Citizenship and Social Entrepreneurship*
- *Open Government*
- *World Café + Open Space Technology,*

And also a visit to two organisations with activity in Collaborative Sharing and Consumption, on the Bari surroundings: *Ex-Fadda e Alberobello Association*.

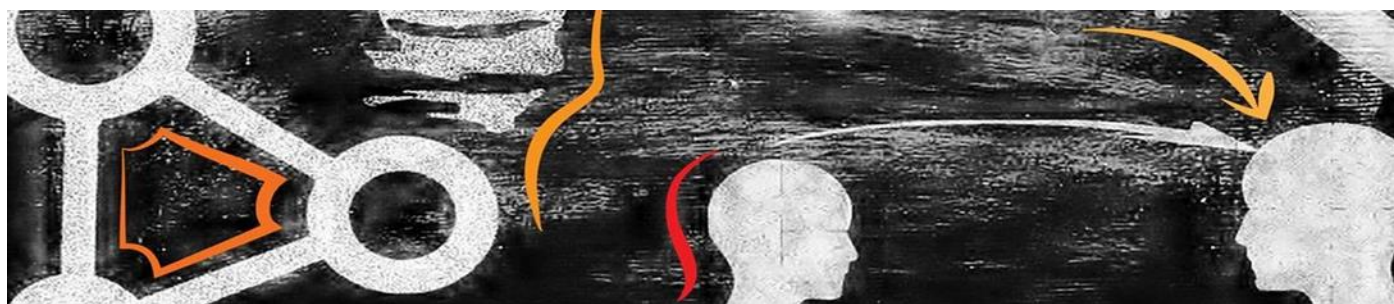
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
