

Third meeting of The Bigger Picture Project

The third partnership meeting took place in Bordeaux, at IFAID facilities located in Sciences Faculty of Bordeaux University. Elements from all partners attended the meeting.

A good part of the meeting was dedicated to finalizing the Competencies Referential in Global Citizenship: to adults, and to Adult Educators. These are available in English and will be available in other partner's languages (Portuguese, Spanish, Italian, French and Estonian) soon.

The competencies included in each referential are the same, but the level of learning is different for each target group.



The competencies included are:

- The Economy and Globalisation
- Global Communication
- Poverty, Hunger and Malnutrition
- Human Rights and Social Justice
- Democracy and Global Citizenship
- Energy
- The Environment



Based on these referential, will be developed, until January 2020, the training course units in Global Citizenship for Adult Educators (coordinated by AidLearn), and the training material to embed in some of the training courses that already exist in the partnership organisations.



Project Background

The globalization, the high degree of interconnectivity and new technological advances have forced many SMEs to reinvent not only their products and services, but also their business and organizational models, in view of staying competitive in a fast-paced economy. Since the majority of European SMEs are involved in global value chains, constant innovation and efficiency are a must to ensure competitiveness in a global context. The growing specialization of knowledge will increasingly be based on collaborative teams, whose integration requires sophisticated social technologies to produce collective innovation.

Project Aims and Objectives

The main goal will be achieved through several **specific objectives**:

- To create a professional profile of Organizational Innovation Coach for SMEs;
- To develop a holistic training course and manual for Organizational Innovation Coaches based on the APGICO's participative innovation model and Creative Problem-Solving protocol;
- To elaborate an educational video which will serve as refresher training, aimed at recalling and reinforcing previously acquired knowledge and skills;
- To create a solid foundation for ensuring the usability of the course for a wider VET audience;
- To develop a concise and focused methodological document aimed at supporting VET providers in the process of using the innovative training content;
- To increase the awareness of EU business and VET community about the importance of organizational innovation and to create the necessary supporting culture for that;
- To provide EU SMEs with open educational resources in the field of organizational innovation.

The course will be framed within a creative process, enabling participants to learn by doing, while using a new social technology and creating new outputs, in terms of anticipating the consequences of possible projects.

FLOURISH Educational Video

The FLOURISH video will serve the purpose of refresher training, aimed at recalling and reinforcing previously acquired knowledge and skills. It is designed as a self-oriented and distance learning tool.

• FLOURISH Guide for VET providers

The Guide will be a concise and focused methodological document aimed at supporting VET providers in the process of using the FLOURISH training content.

Following the FLOURISH methodology SMEs will be able to introduce new forms of work organization, ensure stronger employee participation in innovation processes, advance the managerial techniques and draw lessons to build on in their continuous improvement.

Second meeting of Project Flourish Project

During the second transnational project meeting held in Szeged (Hungry) during the 8 and 9 of July, in Csongrad County Chamber of Commerce and Industry /CSMKIK. in July 2019, the partnership discussed the tasks related to the second intellectual output, which is the Curriculum, Course and Manual for Learners.

So far, the first version of the documents have been prepared taking into account the peer-reviews of the consortium. The currently running activity is its evaluation by the External Pool of Evaluators. After the finalization, the content will be translated to the following languages: Polish,

Second meeting of Project SPIDW in Bulgaria

On 16-17 July 2019 in Sofia, Bulgaria was organized second transnational project meeting of the Project Nr: 2018-1-DE02-KA204-005076 Strategic Partnership for older people's inclusion into the digital world – SPIDW.

Event host organization was BASD, Bulgaria. The main idea of the project is adult trainers to be trained how to improve digital skills of the older people. There are three trainings planned – the first one was organized in February 2019 in Germany. The second one will be in September 2019 in Slovenia and the third one – in

May 2020 in Portugal. Each partner will make at least two films (14 total) together with seniors using mobile phones. Older people will be involved in many activities and will be applied good practiced as narrative interviews, digital storytelling, distant learning, Web TV, etc. All activities and events will improve social inclusion of the older people and will give them the chance to send their messages to the world through digital devices. At the meeting were discussed quality of the project results so far and the planning of the next project steps. The overall evaluation of the project progress, management and implementation are very good.

Inserted in the area of Social Work and Orientation training, through a partnership with the Associação da Carlotazinha, Leiria, on September 24th we started the Second Edition of the **ADC Caregiver** Course.

This training course is aimed at professionals who are already working in this area and wish to update or acquire new knowledge and skills; people wishing to learn basic concepts related to the caregiver function for their own purposes, such as helping / caring for the elderly or caring for children; and people who want personal development or increase their knowledge in this area.

The 55 hour **ADC Caregiver** course, until December 2019, aims to acquire the knowledge and techniques necessary to care for the elderly, with the following objectives:

- Know the characteristics of users in the physical, mental, cultural, social and care aspects, taking into account the respective stage of the life cycle;
- Know how to act in situations of immobility, incontinence, falls, dementias, among others;
- Know the support networks for clients and caregivers, among others.

The program of this course, is based on the following Training Modules:

Module 1 - Caregiver; Module 2 - Music Therapy; Module 3 - Health; Module 4 - Physiotherapy.
