In Portugal, the workshop, took place in Almada, as a certified ACD for teachers, with the collaboration of AlmadaForma and Agrupamento de Escolas Emídio Navarro, and was attended by the presence of around 50 participants. 4th SMS Project Meeting, 30 and 31 January, Bologna, Italy

The 4th meeting took place in Bologna (Italy) on the 30 and 31 January, with the presence of all partners. The very encouraging results of the SMS course pilot action 2, for migrant women, which occurred in each partner country, were discussed; in Portugal the pilot took place in 3 different locations. The next activities will focus on the preparation of national reports and the final report, as well as the finalization of the platform / hub, where the products are hosted, including the different language versions; and their migration to another server.

Multiplier events in each country were discussed, which should take place by the end of August, and which, given the current conditions, will most likely have to happen online.

The modules of the blended course were presented, and the changes to be carried out to ensure greater homogenization were agreed; each module will have a face-to-face session to be held during the adult educators learning week in London in May. The proposed structure for the online course was discussed and agreed.

Regarding the national reports already carried out, each partner must translate their own. The Spanish partner will prepare a summary of everyone's conclusions, which will be translated into all the languages of the partnership.



The guidelines for the creation of Thematic Workshops, the Materials Embedded in Curriculum, and the Guide for Educators are also outlined.

With the current pandemic situation in the world, it is likely that there will be a reschedule of the various activities, including the training of adult educators in May. Be alert!

AidLearn at Nacional Level

Within the scope of our training offer and inserted in the area of Social Work and Orientation, through a partnership with the Associação Carlotazinha, Leiria, the Third Edition of the **ADC Cuidador Course** started in March 2020.

This training course is aimed at professionals who already work in this area and wish to update or acquire new knowledge and skills; people who want to learn the basic concepts related to the role of caregiver for their own purposes, such as helping / caring for the elderly or caring for children; and people who want personal development or increase their knowledge in this area.

The 55-hour **ADC Cuidador Course** aims to acquire the knowledge and techniques necessary to care for the elderly with the following objectives:

- To know the characteristics of users in physical, mental, cultural, social and care aspects, taking into account the respective stage of the life cycle;
- To know how to act in situations of immobility, incontinence, constipation, falls, dementia, among others;
- To know the support networks for users and caregivers, among others.

The programmatic structure of this course, in classroom training, is based on the following Training Modules:

Module 1 - Caregiver; Module 2 - Music therapy; Module 3 - Health; Module 4 - Physiotherapy







A training course was also held on March, 14th and 15th in Arruda dos Vinhos, about "Works at Height" Level I, lasting 16 hours.

This training course, for workers who are responsible for carrying out work at height using ropes, aimed to develop their skills in the context of work at height.

With a mixed methodological approach, expository in the classroom, analysis and discussion of case studies and demonstration, with a practical component, teamwork was encouraged, providing preventive and corrective measures for carrying out work at height by rope, to reduce and / or prevent accidents.

The trainers Vítor Canha and Bruno Canha were responsible for promoting this course.

The participation in this course requires that trainees have PPE of work at heights.
