DIDO is a European project that aims to increase motivation for adult learning across Europe, offering an online toolkit with effective and practical methods to prevent the dropout rate in adult education.

The "Drop in the Dropouts" Webinar organized by GO! CVO Antwerpen, the coordinator of the DIDO project, took place on May 13, 2020. More than 140 people interested in adult education, including adult educators, trainers, counsellors, technicians, and policymakers involved in this sector of adult education from several European countries attended this event. The project coordinator, Hannelore Audenaert, welcomed the participants and streamlined the Webinar, followed by psychologist Sarah Neyts, a school dropout specialist, who explained the reasons for high school students early dropping out of school and how adult education can be a solution for completing their studies.



The director of GO! CVO Antwerpen, Nathalie Schacht, presented the model adopted by the Belgian adult education center to measure in practice the early dropout of adults from the learning process and the strategies that this organization includes in its policy to prevent this dropout. Before a short break, Hannelore Audenaert presented the aims of the Drop-in the dropouts / DIDO project, the partner organizations, and the products developed over these 33 months. After the break, each project partner presented one of the tools they developed; Márcia Silva and Marisol Carmelino, representatives of AidLearn, presented the Success Stories tool! The analysis of the Webinar's evaluation questionnaires allows us to state that 90% of the participants considered that the lessons learned during this event would be beneficial for their professional activities; 95% said that they intend to try one or more tools, and 85% will recommend the DIDO toolkit to colleagues.

We can say that the "Drop in the Dropouts" Webinar was a success!



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
