

On February 12 there was a GainKids project meeting, where the project logo was decided and the development of GainKids products was discussed. Also on March 22, another meeting was held to discuss the project website (soon to be available at www.gainkids.eu) and the project's social media pages.

The goal of this project is to promote Global Citizenship at the pre-school level based on the Convention



on the Rights of the Child, in its different categories, aiming to encourage, through a three-dimensional approach, actions for children, training for teachers and professionals and also raise awareness among families.

Equal Opportunities, Non-Discrimination, Gender Equality and Diversity are the themes that will be explored in this project, which will result in the production of a Pedagogical Kit, in which the children will also be involved during the reflection and production of the final instruments.



UPSIM: Upskilling Paths for Social Integration of Migrants is an Erasmus+ project aimed at migrant women to help them develop soft skills and language skills to achieve their educational goals.



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The UPSIM project has started its data collection phase and each partner country is interviewing people from the project's target groups.

During the week of March 5, AidLearn conducted three interviews with technical staff working on the integration of migrant women. The data acquired provides interesting insights that will help in the creation of more suitable and accurate products for migrant women.

More interviews will be conducted in the future, including with representatives of the target groups.




The launch meeting for the HYBVET project was held on the 24th. The preparatory work to be done was discussed, hybrid training and its massive implementation was defined, namely the success in training surgeons. The partner responsible for this presentation has a lot of experience in hybrid training and their technology has already been implemented in several countries, inside and outside Europe.

Aspects related to the coordination, dissemination and quality of the project were also discussed,

as well as which sectors the partner organizations are interested in implementing this type of training. At the moment, the partners are carrying out case studies on four national industries, to better inform the decisions to be made about the future beneficiaries of the training.

AidLearn at the National level!



AidLearn has recently seen funding approved for vocational training projects at the national level and taking place in 2021 | 2022 for the Central and Alentejo regions.

In the Center region, the Distance Learning Course on Photography and Digital Imaging, a Short Duration Training Unit (*Unidade de Formação de Curta Duração* - UFCD) with a duration of 25 hours, started on March 17th.

In the Alentejo region, the courses on Social Competence and Risk Control and Hygiene and Risk Control at Work started on March 22nd. They are part of the POISE project (project number: POISE-01-3524-FSE-003340), each one lasting 200 hours and running from Monday to Friday, from 8am to 1pm.
