

The GainKids project has also been quite active with project meetings. On April 26th, the project team established and worked on the first output, the questionnaire and focus groups to be done with educators and professionals towards analyzing their Global Citizenship and Global Education knowledge and competences.



Then, on May 31st, the partners met again. At this point, the aforementioned questionnaires and focus groups were already underway and the partners were collecting information on Global Citizenship Education for young children. The partners are very excited to analyse the data and share the results!

Finally, it was decided to postpone to September the face-to-face meeting in Poland, due to the pandemic.

UPSIM: Upskilling Paths for Social Integration of Migrants is an Erasmus+ project aimed at migrant women to help them develop soft skills and language skills to achieve their educational goals. **Learn more at:**

The first phase of the UPSIM project continued with interviewing migrant women. In Portugal, we conducted 8 online interviews: 3 of them with low-skilled migrant women who wish to continue studying and get a higher education, and 5 with migrant women who already graduated. From this we were able to collect important data for the creation of UPSIM project products! The women interviewed were between the ages of 23 to 54 and had very diverse origins: South Sudan, Romania, Ukraine, Italy, China and Brazil.



Each partner also collected information on the demographics of migrant women, and what institutions and tools exist in their country to support their inclusion in society and at work. The partnership is currently finalizing these national reports, in order to finalize and present the first UPSIM result, the Conceptual Referencial.






The Erasmus+ project ECN4MI: Establishment of a coordinated and collaborative network on migrant issues in Europe aims to create and develop a collaborative network in Europe for the social inclusion of migrants and refugees.



The third project meeting for ECN4MI was held on the 15th of June. In this meeting, the partners reviewed the case studies and discussed them. This discussion was incredibly important towards the goal of adapting these strategies to the Lithuanian situation which is currently worsening with more refugees arriving. This makes it more pertinent to develop and adapt specific models towards the social inclusion of migrants and refugees.

AidLearn had a very busy 2nd trimester with the launch of 8 vocational and training courses at the national level.



In the Alentejo region - Almodôvar | POISE-01-3524- FSE-003340, AidLearn implemented 5 face-to-face vocational and training courses all from the training area Safety and Health at Work, as follows:

 Emergency Management, Prevention and Professional Risk Assessment In the Center region - Leiria | POISE-01-3524- FSE-003359, started on the 16th of April, with a duration of 75 hours, the online training course Drawing and Image Treatment with 21 participants This particular training will finish on the 14th July and is monitored by Alexandre Figueiredo and Ley Garcia!



Course with a duration of 75 hours was accomplished from 10th to 28th May with 15 participants.

• Course on Fire Management, Safety and Health at Work 1 had 15 participants and 150 hours, started on the 14th June and will finish on the 23rd July, from 2:00 to 7:00 pm.



- Course on Fire Management, Safety and Health at Work 2 with the duration of 150 hours was initiated on the 14th June to be finished by the 23 July (8:00 am to 1:00 pm) with 15 participants.
- Safety Management and Occupational Risk Prevention Course | 1 with 150 hours that started on the 14th June will finish on the 23rd July with 15 participants.
- Safety Management and Occupational Risk Prevention 2, also with 150 hours started with 15 participants on the 28th June and will finish at 6th August.

Additionally, the theoretical aspects of the course of Ordontopediatry coordinated by Prof. Dra. Joana Farto were held at AidLearn's facilities, starting on the 24th of June





Finally, a new edition of the training course ADC Take Carer initiated on June 15th, in cooperation with Associação da Carlotazinha, 10 participants attended this edition.





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
