






The UPSIM partnership met on September 22nd through ZOOM to analyse and discuss the improvements of the Theoretical Framework of the UPSIM project. This document

compiles information on welcoming systems and demogra data of migrant women in each of the partner countries, as well as the analysis content of the interviews carried out with the two target groups (TGs) of the project:

TG1: migrant women who want to pursue their academic studies, and migrant women who have completed their academic path in the host country;



and

TG2: technicians and volunteers who work with TG1 in terms of social work, integration, language training, counselling/mentoring, etc.

Then, the partnership focused on the discussion of the basic theoretical concepts for the learning approach of the UPSIM project, the implementation of this approach and its concepts in the UPSIM learning platform.



The Manual for the Implementation of Successful Inclusion Workshops will present the UPSIM Mentorvention Circles approach that articulates the concepts of mentoring, learning to learn (L2L) and self-learning, and their interconnection with a circular model of self-learning of the language that will be presented in the Rapid Language Acquisition Tool.





UPSIM: Upskilling Paths for Social Integration of Migrants is an Erasmus+ project aimed at migrant women to help them develop soft skills and language skills to achieve their educational goals. Learn more at:



The GainKids team finally had the opportunity to meet in person after such a long time of working online, as they held their first transnational meeting in Lodz, Poland during the 9th-11th of September. The University of Łódź hosted the meeting and welcomed the team in their city while offering space to talk and work. Besides working, also cultural activities were scheduled, through and during which the team could get to know each other and the city. On the agenda of this first Transnational Meeting, many important discussion points were tackled, focusing on the process and development of the various Intellectual Outputs









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On the first day, the team revised the Focus Group research and took a look at the survey on Global Citizenship, which was conducted in each country with Early Schools educators.

Considering the developments of the COVID pandemic in all countries, the team is certain that the research will be terminated by the end of this year. Moreover, after meeting in Lodz, the team will start working on piloting the Guidelines for the Storybooks and interviews with children, as well as the Video Collection. The Handbook for



children educators and technicians is also initialized, as the team discussed the first draft of it while establishing guidelines for the next working steps on the Handbook.

On day two, the GainKids team concentrated on planning and organising the dissemination, agreed on distributing tasks and responsibilities and drafted future working schedules.



Particularly based on our experiences with the RefugeesIN project, we examined the great potential art can have for interventions that aim to achieve social inclusion. To do so, we conducted a meta-study which focused only on qualitative articles that included the voices of the beneficiaries of such interventions themselves, thereby "re-voicing the unheard".





AidLearn at the National level

During the past three months, AidLearn provided five professional training courses at the national level.



Within the scope of the Professional Training Project financed by the POISE program for the Alentejo region, the actions 3 and 4 of the Fire Management, Safety and Health at the Workplace course started on September 6th, with a duration of 150 hours each.

Moreover, and also in the Alentejo region, the Health and Safety at Work and Prevention of Occupational Diseases Course started on September 20th, with a duration of 75 hours; this course is taught by trainer Pedro Aniceto.
