











HOPE: Home and Overseas Project Management Excellence intends to create a professional training course for project managers in the community development sector.



NEW PROJECTS!

Besides the aforementioned projects which have already had their launch meetings and/or some form of online meetings and are starting to be developed, a few others have also been financed and will be starting soon!

- EASY was approved by the Polish National Agency in the Adult Education action with the aim of addressing gender and age stereotypes in the workplace.
- CarboNostrum was approved by the Portuguese National Agency in the Vocational and Education Training action, and aims to develop educational and training resources to apply mitigation and adaptation solutions to climate change in poor soils and degraded Mediterranean ecosystems, contributing to the promotion of green employability, sustainable agricultural practices, food production within a reduced carbon footprint and preservation of traditional knowledge and modes of production, while exploring innovative approaches to environmental valuation within the current and relevant political and economic framework.
- CECIL, approved by the Portuguese National Agency in the Adult Education action, aims to promote the Circular Economy and Sustainability among women at risk of exclusion, promoting greater interaction between the European Green Agreement and the European Strategy for Gender Equality 2020-2025.


