






Then, on the 18th of February the HOPE partnership met again through Zoom to discuss the glossary which was being finalized, as well as a questionnaire on project management.





Finally, on the 25th of March, the partnership got together, once again, on an online format to do the final adjustments on the glossary which shall be made available very soon!



On the 4th of March, there was another meeting for the HEDY project. 







The first meeting of the CarboNostrum project happened on the 1st of February. During this meeting, the project's objectives were discussed and well as its target groups.


The Kick-off meeting for the CECIL project occurred online on the 27th of January. The project focuses on the combination of circular economy education and social inclusion for women at

The ECN4MI project now has its own website! Additionally, the partnership has been invested in disseminating the project and discussing the results. AidLearn has focused on why Portugal was still welcoming refugees from all over the world, partly because it has one of the highest numbers of elderly people in the EU and thus needs young people to come work to ensure its economic sustainability, even before the current worldwide wave of solidarity towards Ukrainian refugees. On this subject, ECN4MI's partnership expressed their support for Ukraine and hopes that the invading troops from the neighboring country withdraw from Ukraine's territory soon. Furthermore, this conflict also serves to reinforce the relevance of projects, such as ECN4MI, aiming to create an effective national network to support the reception and social inclusion of refugees.



On the 16th of February, the YOUCAN partnership met online for the first time to officially launch the project! The partners introduced themselves and the project's first steps were discussed, particularly the first transnational meeting in Turin.

YOUCAN aims to be a reference addressing the drop-out of youths with migrant background. 

During the past three months, AidLearn has once again provided several professional training courses at the national level in both the Alentejo and Centre regions of Portugal.

Then, on the 28th of March, the actions 3 and 4 of the Personal, Social and Professional Skills Laboratories course started, each with a duration of 150 hours.
