


YOUCAN's first transnational project meeting in Turin, Italy, had a remarkably full agenda and was very enriching for the partners! Not only could the partners get acquainted with one another, AMECE also created an agenda that went beyond just discussing the project's results. Indeed, they had the partnership visit diverse actors relevant to the social inclusion and prevention of migrant youth dropout.

Firstly, the partnership discussed the project and, particularly the O2Os (Organisation to Organisation) and the first result which will have a collection of good practices regarding the prevention of migrant youth dropout, but also regarding the 3 projects to be submitted to other calls within this project's lifecycle.

After the project was discussed, the partners were visited by the Secretary of the Municipality of Turin which talked about the municipality's policies regarding migrants, particularly migrant youth, and other main actors (e.g., youth organisations, mosques, churches, etc). This was followed by the partners visiting CPIA 3, a centre for education of adults, where they were invited into a classroom with migrant youths and got to chat and meet them as well as meet educators and youth workers that work directly with them. Finally, the partners also visited the

Primo Levi library.









Then, on the week of 20th to the 24th of June, there was the first O2O of the project! The project's O2Os serve as a way for partners to share their know-how and good practices as well as set up meetings with relevant organisations so the visiting partner gets a better idea of the national reality of the host partner. This also serves to strenghten and/or establish networks for both partners.

This first O2O was in Lisbon and hosted by AidLearn with a visitor from ECEPAA. During the meeting, AidLearn presented its projects dealing with migrants, with social inclusion, and citizenship, and presented their published study regarding arts-based interventions for the social inclusion of refugeed and asylum-seekers.

Additionally, they also met with a refugee in Portugal to get his inputs, had a guided visit to the Galeria de Arte Pública in Quinta do Mocho with the presence of the Chief of the Division of Culture, Sports, and Youth who discussed the municipality's policies for social inclusion, had a meeting with Aga Khan foundation, visited the Clube Intercultural Europeu, and two meetings with Portuguese teachers who work with migrants.


The HOPE project has, once again, been quite active!

Firstly, on April 25 the project had another online meeting to discuss the next steps regarding the survey that was being applied at that time. Additionally, the partnership discussed the in-person transnational project meeting in Bordeaux and the HOPE Glossary.

This was followed by the aforementioned transnational project meeting in Bordeaux,



France, on May 3 and 4. During said meeting, the partnership discussed the finalization of the multilingual glossary and progress on the questionnaire. AidLearn at the National level

During the past three months, AidLearn has once again provided several professional training courses at the national level in the Alentejo, the Centre, and the Lisbon and Tagus Valley regions of Portugal.

Firstly, in Alentejo, action 5 of the Personal, Social and Professional Skills Laboratories course, as well as the Storage Layout, Provisioning, and Interpersonal Communication course, started on April 15th and each had a duration of 150 hours.

Then, on the 25th of May, the Principles of Ergonomics and Prevention of Accidents and Occupational Diseases course started and had a 25 hour duration.

Lastly, the Fire Management in Buildings and Occupational Health and Safety course, and actions 1 and 2 of the Computer Systems in Warehouse Management and Digital Communication course, which started on the 6th of June, with the Fire Management in Buildings and Occupational Health and Safety course having a duration of 100 hours, and each of the actions of the Computer Systems in Warehouse Management and Digital Communication course having a 50 hour duration.
