The ENTRUST project was very active this trimester.

On the 1st of July, the Entrust projet team went to Porto de Mós and visited Esperança, an entrepreneur that funded Victoria Handmade, the company that produces these tradicional reed baskets. The team has recorded with Esperança an inspiring documentary that will be available at the end of the Entrust projet, enriching the official 8 documentaries list.





Some days later, the team went to Lajeosa do Mondego, a village in the municipality of Celorico da Beira and visited José and Maria, the owners of Casas do Durão, Memories House, an 18th-century Local Accommodation establishment that provides its guests with a personalized and traditional type of accommodation. The team has recorded with them one out of two oficial documentaries, in Portugal.

On September 23, the team shooted the second official documentary, in Portugal, this time with Maria da Graça Saraiva, in Chamusca. She showed us the Observatory of the Charneca Landscape, which is based in a former agricultural warehouse, and is a support space for meetings, workshops, events and activities related to knowledge and scientific tourism. Here the opportunities and threats for the enhancement of the landscape and its resources are identified, taking into account options for local development, in order to better enjoy the Ribatejo landscape.











On the 13th and 14th of September AidLearn hosted in its Lisbon office the European partners of the Eco Hosting. The next steps of the project were discussed.

On 25th and 26th of July the project partners had the first face-to-face meeting of the project team, hosted by Mine Vaganti NGO, in Alghero, Sardinia (Italy). The meeting addressed the progress of the project, reviewed the status of the various outputs (CECIL Guide, CECIL Toolkit and CECIL Professional Network)

and defined the tasks under development.



Between the 10th and the 15th of October the project partners were in Volos (Greece), where they participated in a training event. After the initial icebreaker, several activities were held, such as team building ("To do list"), familiarisation with the concept of Social Inclusion ("Take a step forward"), and about the concept of Circular Economy and how it can make a difference on a daily basis. On the other days of the event the activities included quizzes games based on Circular Economy, the activity "Eggs Apocalypse", in which participants had the opportunity to learn about co-design and an activity called "Story of my life". At the end they held a short evaluation session and a questionnaire.

EASY: Educating Adults Against Stereotypes aims to promote understanding of age and gender stereotypes that can lead to discrimination in different sectors of society among adults. It will provide teaching resources for adult educators to use to facilitate inclusion and diversity.



The EASY project continues to progress according to planned. After meticulous analysis of the focus group and extensive literature research, the team was engaged in the definition of the criteria and the selection process of the films and comics about stereotypes that will compose the project catalogue. From an original sample of over 120 comics and films, each partner chose 25 each for a new round of selection. In the end, the 12 most interesting films and 12 comics from a pedagogical point of view will become part of the catalogue.

AidLearn at the National level

AidLearn developed, in the past three months, several vocational training courses at national level.

On July 16 and 17, in Arruda dos Vinhos, it was held the Work at Height course (level I), with the duration of 16 hours; the trainers Bruno Canha and Vítor Canha assured this course. Then, within the scope of the Vocational Training project for the Alentejo region, actions 1 and 2 of the course on Personal Skills Laboratory, Safety at Work and Risk Assessment and Control, each lasting 200 hours, began on the 12th August. Finally, on the 14th of August, the Operating Systems course took place in the central region, with the duration of 75 hours, taught by the trainer Ley Garcia.









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
