

In early May, AidLearn took part in a training course in Cáceres to develop skills in "managing a European project"! The focus was on the topic of the YOUCAN project - strengthening the educational response to school dropout among young migrants and social exclusion.







In the context of human rights and migration laws, the terms migrants, asylum seekers and refugees describe different scenarios involving the movement of people between countries.

<u>Migrants</u>: includes anyone who moves within or between countries for various reasons, such as work, studies, family or personal opportunities;

<u>Asylum Seekers</u>: request international protection due to fears of persecution, violence or discrimination in their country of origin;

<u>Refugees</u>: recognized due to well-founded fears of persecution or serious risk to their lives in their country of origin, and entitled to special assistance and protection under international law.



Peer mentoring is "a relationship between people who are at the same career stage or age, where one person has more experience than the other in a particular field and can provide support as well as transfer knowledge and skills" (Art of mentoring, n.d.).

The mentor, despite sharing similar experiences, supports the mentee because they have strong coping strategies* or professional experience.

On June 5, the project's Portuguese conference took place at the Sabugal Municipal Auditorium, with the support of the Sabugal municipality and ADES - Sabugal Business Association.

Dina Ramos presented the research underway at the University of Aveiro, highlighting the developing trends in rural tourism and the potential for preserving heritage through responsible tourism practices. António Silva Pina presented the Eco Hosting project's learning platform, which offers a series of free, interactive resources aimed at reducing the environmental impact of tourism in European natural areas, providing educational materials and encouraging tourists and establishment managers to adopt sustainable practices.

On May 16, the pilot action for the E-Silver Tour project took place at the Inatel Foundation Training Center in Lisbon!

Participants included a representative from Rutis (the Network of Senior Universities), a member of a Senior University, travel agents and tourism technicians from the Inatel Foundation. Due to the great commitment and interest shown by those present, the action proved to be very useful, as many suggestions were made, which will be considered in order to improve the online platform and make it more intuitive and functional for future users.



On June 21, the E-SilverTour International Conference was held in partnership with ISCE - Instituto Superior de Lisboa e Vale do Tejo.

The keynote speaker was Prof. Luiz Moutinho, who addressed the topic of technological development (Digital Marketing) in the present and future, emphasizing its importance and impact on the silver economy. The project partners, E-SENIORS (Paris, France) and 50 + HELLAS (Athens, Greece), then presented the main results of the project.

The needs analysis, through separate questionnaire surveys, revealed that senior tourists consider themselves connected to digital media, are comfortable with the English language and are looking for trips tailored to their abilities and preferences. Professionals, on the other hand, are willing to consider the expectations of senior tourists. It's important to note that the senior population is quite heterogeneous, and diversification of the tourist offer is recommended!

António Pina, from AidLearn, presented the B-Learning platform, where the second result of the project, an innovative digital marketing course for Senior Tourism and Active Ageing, will be available. At the end of the conference, two good practices in senior tourism in Portugal were presented, led by the Inatel Foundation, represented by Dr. Elsa Caramujo, and Rutis, represented by Dr. Luís Jacob.

Our goal is for adults to understand the stereotypes that can lead to discrimination, improving the availability of high-quality learning opportunities for adults at the same time that will help the inclusion and diversity in all fields of education, training, youth and sports.



The EASY Project - Educating Adults Against Stereotypes - developed in a context of unprecedented challenges and opportunities faced by the world, such as increasing globalization, will soon make available one of its results, the EASY Catalogue of Films and Cartoons. The Catalogue, which is currently being finalized, includes a series of films (feature films and shorts) and "cartoons" (comics and/or "strips") depicting social stereotypes and the different social forms by which a society can be organized.

During the development of the project, a significant change occurred, marked by the dissolution of Romania's Association for Education for Social Development (AESD), which was replaced by Bulgaria's ACTA Foundation, which took on the responsibility of continuing the legacy of the AESD.
