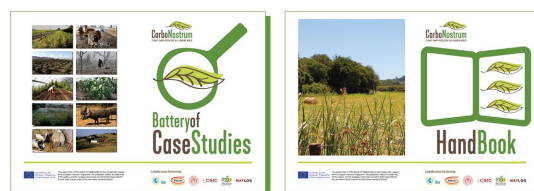

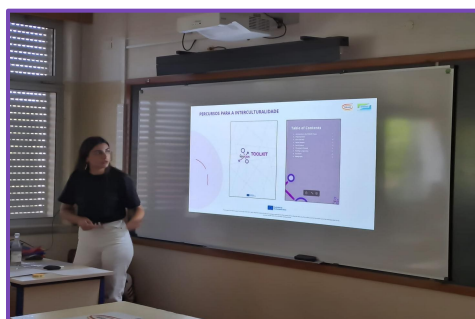


Bringing the Project to a Close: Sharing Results at Two School Events

A Learning Event in Denmark: Testing EASY Project Activities

As part of the GAINKids project, we are delighted to share that the collection of children's storybooks has arrived! Under the theme of Global Citizenship and based on the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

3. Equal opportunities for all children - "Unicorn friends"
4. Global citizenship, citizenship and participation - "Cat-mia-melodia"
5. Nondiscrimination and diversity - "Monster of the rainforest"

The collection will be distributed to schools, and other entities working with children.
