

Current Project Activities

LTTA - Documentary & Podcast Workshop

From May 5 to 7, in Serpa and Mértola, MedSEVa project partners took part in the Documentary & Podcast Workshop, a training activity, where they learned to create documentaries and podcasts as storytelling tools for sustainability.

Partners developed practical skills in filming, audio recording, and editing, with creative results and strong teamwork!

MedSEVa's TPM

Following the Workshop, the Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) was held on May 8th, where partners shared updates and planned the next steps for MedSEVa.

A key focus was the second project result, the Storytelling: StoryMaps Creation Guide, which will serve as the foundation for the Interactive StoryMap.



The team defined the implementation strategy, timeline, and key challenges in crafting inspiring narratives about Mediterranean ecosystems.

AidLearn also presented templates to support partners in developing their local stories.



Focus Group

On May 20th, 2025, AidLearn co-organised the MedSEVa project Focus Group in Lisbon, in partnership with The USE Concept.

The event brought together researchers, teachers, farmers, land managers, and cartography specialists to reflect on Mediterranean shrubland ecosystems — rich landscapes essential to biodiversity, climate regulation, and rural livelihoods, yet often overlooked.

Discussions explored sustainable land management practices, the role of Traditional Ecological Knowledge in conservation, and the use of public policies and digital tools to foster ecological resilience.





The insights gathered will guide the next steps of the MedSEVa project, reinforcing AidLearn's commitment to connecting research, education, and sustainability through European cooperation initiatives.




EduAl Documentary Published on YouTube!

KALOSKAMI S.A. (AXIA). This in-person event marked a pivotal
phase in the piloting of the IntCultAE learning approach, as participants actively engaged with the core materials developed through the project.

Educators and trainers from all partner countries browsed the three core MOOC modules, each focused on a critical dimension of intercultural education: Culture and Us, Migration, and Intercultural Competencies in Education, to test platform functionalities. For three days all educators and trainers, engaged in face-to-face training sessions based on the three MOOC modules, contributed to lively discussions, and participated in interactive workshops— exploring issues such as cultural identity, acculturation, migration, discrimination, and culturally responsive teaching.

Over the course of the three days, participants contributed meaningful feedback on the course design, workshop methods, and pedagogical tools, offering insights that will directly inform improvements to the Workshop Guide. The LTTA also served as a valuable moment of peer learning and exchange, reinforcing the project's commitment to building a strong community of practice around intercultural competences in adult education.

MOOC (ONLINE LEARNING COURSE)



The IntCultAE MOOC is a free, modular course tailored to adult educators working in multicultural settings. It includes three modules — Culture and Us, Migration, and Intercultural Competencies in Education — offering both theoretical content and interactive activities. With a online learning format, the course supports flexible, self-paced study as well as in-person implementation. Following valuable feedback from LTTA participants, the course is currently being finalized and refined.

Teamwork was strongly encouraged, along with the adoption of preventive and corrective measures for rope-based work at heights, to reduce and/or eliminate accidents.


