




### Final Transnational Partner Meeting

As part of the EduAI project, we recently had the privilege of conducting an interview with Prof. Dr. Paulo Nuno Vicente at Universidade NOVA de Lisboa. An Associate Professor in Digital Media and the Founder and Coordinator of the iNOVA Media Lab, Prof. Vicente's work spans immersive and interactive narratives, the social impact of artificial intelligence, web platforms and social networks, innovation, and digital transformation.

Through this exchange, we explore how the integration of artificial intelligence can reshape higher education, addressing both its challenges and opportunities, as well as effective strategies for meaningful implementation.

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
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## Employability Forum 2025 at ISCTE

We would like to thank ISCTE for the invitation and for the excellent organisation of the forum, which once again created a valuable space for dialogue between organisations, students, and future professionals.

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
